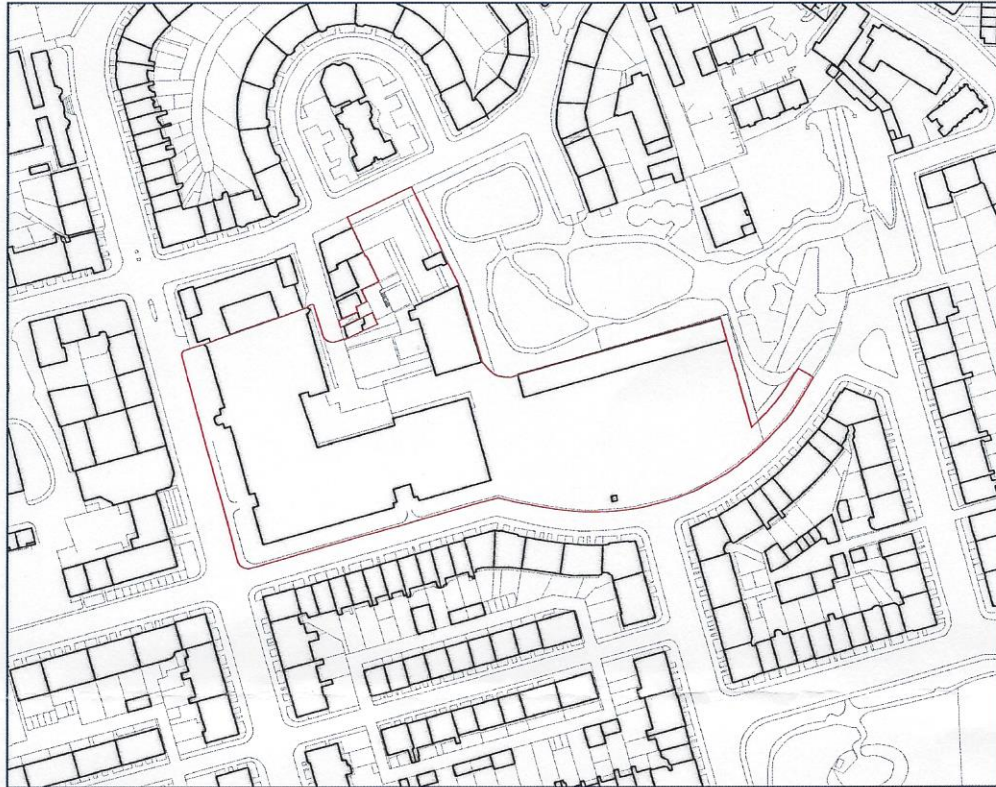


105 & 113 Dundas Street, 34 Fettes Row and land at Eyre Terrace/Royal Crescent, Edinburgh



The Royal Bank of Scotland (RBS) is hosting a series of community consultation exhibitions regarding proposals for land within its ownership at Dundas Street, Fettes Row, Eyre Terrace and Royal Crescent, Edinburgh.

RBS has announced plans to close its existing offices at Dundas Street/Fettes Row and relocate staff to its headquarters at Gogarburn, Edinburgh. RBS is therefore proposing the redevelopment of the site for residential led mixed use development.

The third and final drop-in public consultation exhibition is being held on **Thursday 25 February at Broughton St Mary's Parish Church, 12 Bellevue Crescent, Edinburgh, EH3 6NE between 3pm and 8pm.**
