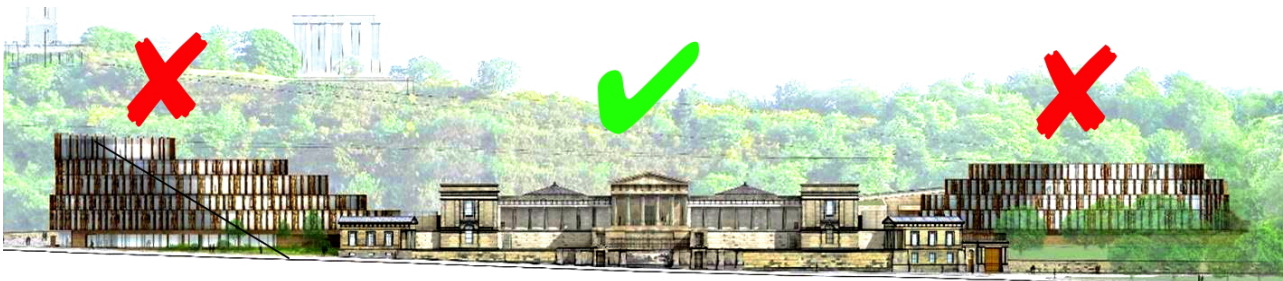




We need your help in saving Thomas Hamilton's magnificent Old Royal High School on Calton Hill.

One of the world's most important Greek Revival buildings, the Old Royal High School, is threatened by a hotel development with massive 'bedroom wings' that would destroy the building as we know it and forever change the appearance of Calton Hill, the acropolis of historic monuments which is the expression of Edinburgh as the 'Athens of the North'.



Moreover the commercialisation of one of Scotland's greatest cultural assets would show the world that Edinburgh does not value its heritage or respect its status as a UNESCO world heritage site.

We can't let this happen.

Later this year there will be a Scottish Government led enquiry. The Cockburn Association, Edinburgh World Heritage and the New Town and Broughton Community Council have joined forces to object to the hotel development and promote the return the building to its original function as a school — St Mary's Music School — preserving the integrity of Hamilton's original design.

The enquiry will last five or six weeks and will be expensive to fight.
