Dear resident

New waste and recycling bin hub locations

We are changing the communal waste and recycling bins in your neighbourhood as part of the communal bin review (CBR) project.

The CBR project aims to improve recycling and waste services for those living in flats. The project will make it easier for residents to recycle by ensuring they have access to a full range of recycling bins: non-recyclable waste, food waste, glass, and mixed recycling.

We are also introducing a new style of food recycling bin, which is easier to use, cleaner and contains odours better. This new style bin is being introduced as a result of previous feedback.

There will be more bins, with general waste and mixed recycling emptied more often than you're used to, so there is space for you to recycle more and less chance of the bins overflowing.

We are creating designated bin hubs to keep communal bins neatly and safely in one location on your street, or a nearby street subject to where you live.

When deciding locations for bin hubs we use agreed parameters and criteria which include:

- safety ensuring the bin hubs are safe for people recycling, pedestrians, cyclists and drivers,
- the walking distance to the bins, particularly for people with mobility problems,
- neighbourhood sizes ensuring there are enough bins for everyone to use,
- placing bins on the road rather than pavements where possible to reduce street clutter and remove obstacles for pedestrians,
- preventing the loss of parking spaces.


