FOOTWAY RECONSTRUCTION WORKS – DUNDAS STREET (between Great Kings Street and Henderson Row)

I am writing to advise that footway reconstruction works are due to commence on or around 4 September 2023, the works will have an approximate duration of fifteen weeks. Please note that the contractor will be setting up welfare and equipment from 28 August 2023 in advance of this start date.

All works will be carried out between the hours of 0700 to 1900 Monday to Friday and will be broken into phases which are summarised below. Please note, this may be subject to change during the construction period. Should there be any significant changes, I will ensure you are kept up to date:

PHASE OF WORKS	TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS
Phase 0 – Pre-start of works. Mobilisation of Contractor, Site set-up and organisation.	Parking suspension on North footways of Great Kings Street either side of Dundas Street for the duration of the project.
Phase 1 – West Footways Between Great Kings Street and Cumberland Street	Parking Suspended and bus stops closed on east and west sections of Dundas Street between Great Kings Street and Cumberland Street. Cumberland Street Closed as required.
Phase 2 – West Footways between Cumberland Street and Fettes Row	Parking Suspended and bus stops closed on east and west sections of Dundas Street between Cumberland Street and Fettes Row. Cumberland Street and Fettes Row Closed as required.
Phase 3 – East Footways between Great Kings Street and Cumberland Street	Parking Suspended and bus stops closed on east and west sections of Dundas Street between Great Kings Street and Cumberland Street. Cumberland Street Closed as required.
Phase 4 – East Footways between Cumberland Street and Fettes Row	Parking Suspended and bus stops closed on east and west sections of Dundas Street between Cumberland Street and Fettes Row. Cumberland Street and Fettes Row Closed as required.
Phase 5 – East Footway between Fettes Row and Henderson Row	Parking Suspended and bus stops closed on east and west sections of Dundas Street between Fettes Row and Henderson Row. Fettes Row Closed and temporary lights on Henderson Row as required.

To allow the works to proceed, a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) will be put in place to close off the various side roads along the length of Dundas Street to vehicles as necessary. Similarly, on-street parking will be suspended as necessary. These restrictions are required to allow the safe programming and execution of the works.

During the works, pedestrian access will be maintained and appropriate local diversions will be put in place to facilitate any road closures. All diversions will be signed and residents may be required to make alternative parking arrangements. Restrictions will only be in place to facilitate the works, with a view of minimising disruption whenever possible.

Street notices, traffic management signage and information boards will be placed on Dundas Street and the surrounding areas to notify stakeholders of the ongoing restrictions. Please ensure you do not park within any restricted areas and allow additional time for traveling in the vicinity of the works. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times. If required, stakeholders may also be kept informed via further correspondence or visits from the contractor as the works progress.

Arrangements shall be made with the Council's Waste Team to ensure refuse collections are maintained. Individuals with private waste disposal arrangements should contact their provider to ensure arrangements are in place during the works.

It is recognised that these works will cause disruption, however, every effort will be made to keep this to a minimum. I apologise in advance for any inconvenience, but I am sure you will benefit from the improvements when the works are complete.
